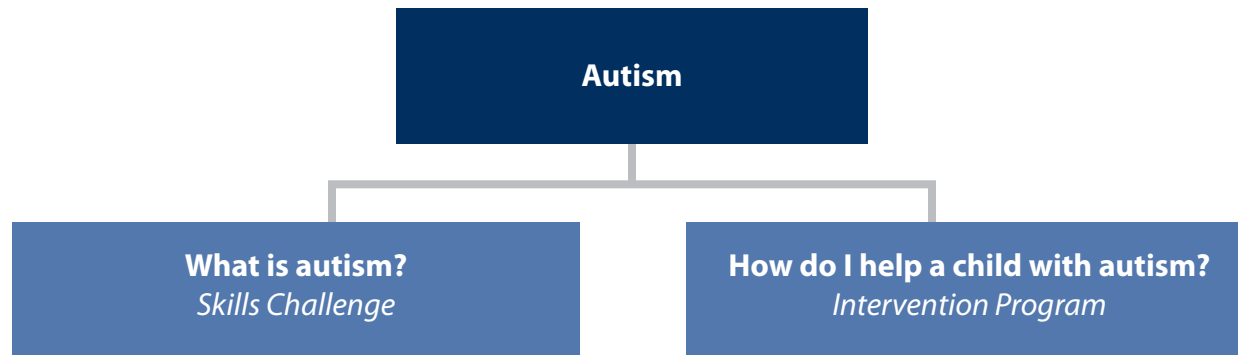
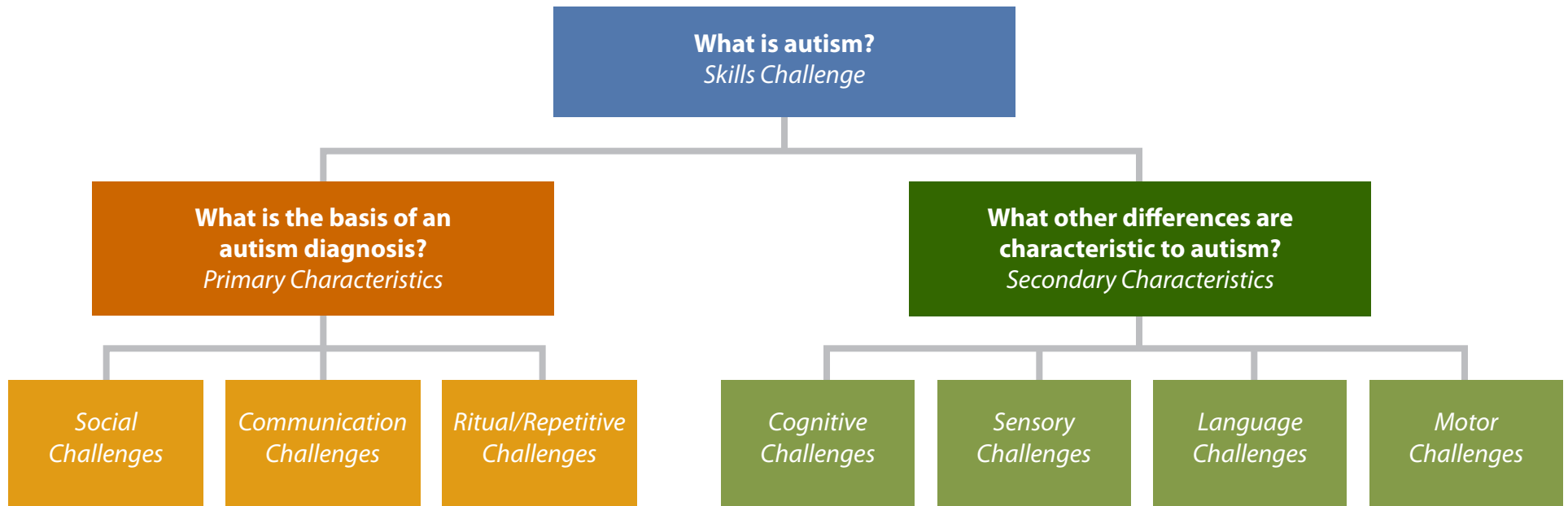


An Overview of AutismPro Workshops
